The Wangdue Phodrang Dzongkhag COVID19 Task Force (DC19TF) is pleased to inform the general public that the DC-19TF has successfully completed the "Community Sweeping" of residents in all Red Zones including the PHPA-I & PHPA-II containment areas on 15 March 2022 in line with the "**Dzongkhag Transition Plan Schedule**" which was endorsed by NC19TF. In total, 51,124 RT-PCR samples were tested since the detection of the first index case in the Dzongkhag.

In continuation to the earlier notifications, the DC19TF hereby notifies the general public on the further relaxations in the Dzongkhag with effect from 18 March 2022 based on the encouraging community sweeping test reports and considering the following "enablers":

- a) High COVID-19 vaccination coverage of eligible individuals (97%) in the Dzongkhag.
- b) Initiation of protection of vulnerable population in facility quarantine.
- c) All the positive cases (271) and primary contacts (446) isolated and home quarantined.
- d) Public health and social measures strengthened.
- e) No COVID19 cases required hospitalization of the total 2363 cases detected in the Dzongkhag as of 17 March 2022.

For the Residents in Red Flats in Yellow areas

- i. The residents must follow the red flat protocol.
- ii. The essential items and services shall be delivered by respective essential delivery teams.
- iii. The residents marked as red flats shall be released after 7 days without testing, if asymptomatic.

General DOs

- I. All individuals to mandatorily wear proper face masks, practice hand hygiene and maintain physical distancing of minimum 1.5 meters.
- II. Mandatory use of Druk Trace App at shops, public transports and other public places.
- III. Individuals with flu like signs and symptoms must get tested at the health center or flu clinics.
